SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Rights of Public Entity

Namibia Wildlife Resorts reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per site, or
- (b) to accept or reject any Bid or to cancel the Bid process; and
- (c) reject all bids at any time prior to contract award.

2. Preparation of Bids

You are requested to quote for the services mentioned in Section III, by completing, signing and returning:

- (a) the Bid Letter in Section II with its annex for Bid Securing Declaration, where applicable;
- (b) the Priced Activity Schedule in Section IV;
- (c) the Specifications and Performance Standards in Section V; and
- (d) any other attachment as deemed appropriate.

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Bids document, including the Contract Data Sheet in Section VII, before preparing your Bid. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

3. Validity of Bids

The Bid validity period shall be for 90 days from the date of submission deadline.

4. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in this Bid exercise, you should:

- (a) have a valid company Registration Certificate;
- (b) have an original valid good Standing Tax Certificate;
- (c) have an original valid good Standing Social Security Certificate;
- (d) have a valid certified copy of Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate, proof from Employment Equity Commissioner that bidder is not a relevant employer, or exemption issued in terms of Section 42 of the Affirmative Action Act, 1998;
- (e) Submit signed Bid-securing Declaration.

Bids should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number and addressed to Namibia Wildlife Resorts with the Bidder's name at the back of the envelope.

9. Submission of Bids

Bids should be deposited in the Bid/Bid Box located at PMU office, second floor, Namibia Wildlife Resorts Head office, Private Bag 13378, 189 Erkrath Building, Windhoek, not later than **Friday**, **23rd February at 11h00**. Offers by post or hand delivered should reach PMU office by the same date and time at latest. Late submission will be rejected.

Bids received by e-mail will not be considered.

10. Opening of Bids

Bids will be opened internally by Namibia Wildlife Resorts immediately after the closing time referred to in section 9 above. A record of the Bid Opening stating the name of the Bidders and the amount, the presence or absence of a Bid-Securing Declaration will be put on the website of Namibia Wildlife Resorts and available to any bidder on request within three working days of the Opening.

The successful bidder will be required to conduct an audit of NWR's financial statements in accordance with the international standards of auditing and issue an audited report/s to the shareholders of the company.

Our financial year end is 31st of October each year and by law we are required to hold an Annual General Meeting within the following six months (30 April of the following year. Therefore an audit report as well as the financial statements need to be completed and distributed to the shareholder at least 21 days prior end of April.

Annual financial statements were compiled on casework by an external auditor for the 31 October 2022 and the same will be done for 31 October 2023. That file was converted into typeset format and printing. NWR can repeat this for the next 3 years. The bidders may suggest alternatives.

The bidders are further required to evaluate the extent of work required on annual report (to which the annual financial statements will be attached) and include it in their respective bids.
